Respected Sir,

Kindly find enclosed herewith a copy of Commission's letter No.78/EPS/2023/5564 dated 31.03.2023. The Election Commission of India has announced the Bye-Elections 2023 to Lok Sabha from 04-Jalandhar (SC) Parliamentary Constituency on 29.03.2023 and Model Code of Conduct was enforced in Jalandhar (SC) Parliamentary Constituency. The poll for the said election will be held on 10.05.2023 (Wednesday).

2. In this regard, your kind attention is invited to Section 135B of the Representation of People Act, 1951 which provides for the grant of paid holiday to the employees on the day of Poll. Every Person employed in any business trade, Industrial Undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at election to the House of People or Legislative Assembly of a State, shall on the day of poll, be granted a holiday. The daily waged/causal workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on poll day as provided in Section 135B of the Representation of People Act, 1951.

3. Your kind attention is also drawn to para 3 of the instructions contained in the Commission's aforesaid letter whereby it is clarified that even those electors including casual workers working outside the constituency

concerned would be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday extended under Section 135B(1) of the Representation of People Act, 1951.

It is, therefore, requested to take steps to declare 10.05.2023 (Wednesday) as Gazetted/Public Holiday in the areas of 04-Jalandhar (SC) Parliamentary Constituency under Negotiable Instrument Act 1881, Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958 (Punjab Act No. 15 of 1958) and The Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act LXIII of 1948).

**Subject:** Conduct of Bye-Elections to 1 (One) Parliamentary Constituency of Punjab and 3 (three) Legislative Assemblies of Odisha and Uttar Pradesh and 1 (one) adjourned poll in Meghalaya - Grant of paid holiday to employees on the day of poll - Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited and to inform that the Commission has announced schedule for Bye-Elections to Parliamentary Constituency and Legislative Assemblies vide its Press Note No. ECI/PN/25/2023 dated 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2023, which is available at Commission's website <https://eci.gov.in> under head 'Press Releases' at URL <https://eci.gov.in/files/file/14862-schedule-for-bye-election-to-clear-vacancies-of-1-one-parliamentary-constituency-of-punjab-and-3-three-legislative-assembly-of-odisha-and-uttar-pradesh-and-1-adjourned-poll-in-meghalaya/> The date of poll has been fixed on **10.05.2023 (Wednesday)** in above mentioned bye/adjourned-poll going States.

2. In this regard, your attention invited to Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which provides for the grant of paid holiday to the employees on the day of poll. The Section 135B is reproduced below:-

**\*135B. Grant of paid holiday to employees on the day of poll.**

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(a) Every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at election to the House of the People or the Legislative Assembly of a State shall, on the day of poll, be granted a holiday.

(b) No deduction or abatement of the wages of any such person shall be made on account of a holiday having been granted in accordance with sub-section (1) and if such person is employed on the basis that he would not ordinarily receive wages for such a day, he shall nonetheless be paid for such day the wages he would have drawn had not a holiday been granted to him on that day.

(c) If an employer contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1) or sub-section (2), then such employer shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to five hundred rupees.

(d) This section shall not apply to any elector whose absence may cause danger or substantial loss in respect of the employment in which he is engaged."


3. The above provisions require that all the electors who are employees of establishments and shops including those which work on shift basis shall be granted a paid holiday on the day of poll in the Constituency where the general election is to be held. Further, there may be cases where a person is ordinarily resident of the Constituency and registered as an elector, may be serving or employed in an industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the Constituency having a bye-election. It is clarified that in such a situation, even those electors including casual workers working outside the constituency concerned would be entitled to the benefit of a paid holiday extended under the Section 135B(1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

4. The daily wage/casual workers are also entitled for a holiday and wages on poll day as provided in Section 135B of the R.P. Act, 1951.

5. The Commission desires that suitable instructions should be issued to all concerned and a copy thereof be endorsed to the Commission for its information and record.
